As part of the UM Sylvester Firefighter Cancer Initiative, Highland Beach will be hosting a Free Skin Cancer Screening Day on Saturday, July 18<sup>th</sup> at our Fire Station located at 3612 S. Ocean Blvd, Highland Beach, FL 33486. Personally, I have had three Squamous Cell Cancers, two of which required surgical removal. The data illustrates that firefighters are at a higher risk for skin cancer than the general population. Please use this free opportunity to get screened and potentially save your life.
